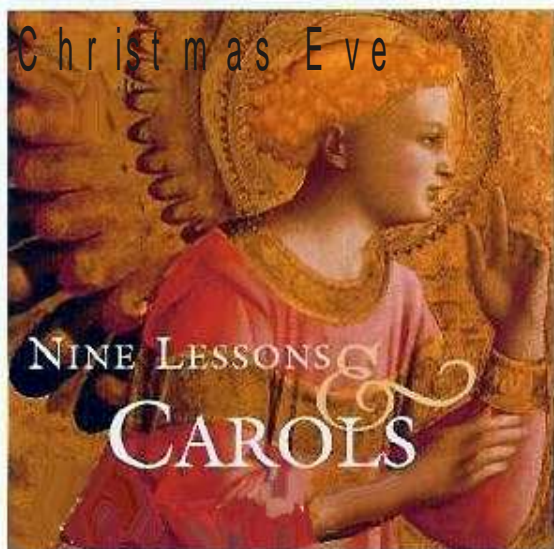

Nine Lessons & Carols

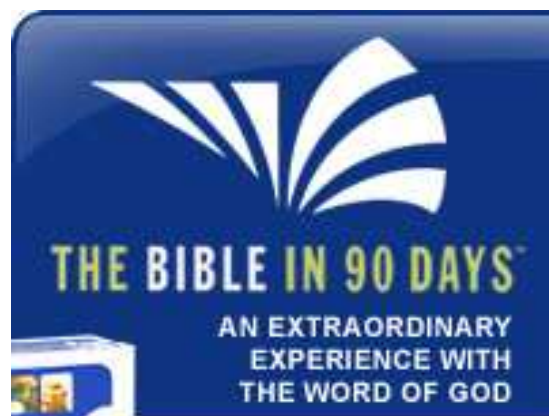
